Petition – asking God for our own needs

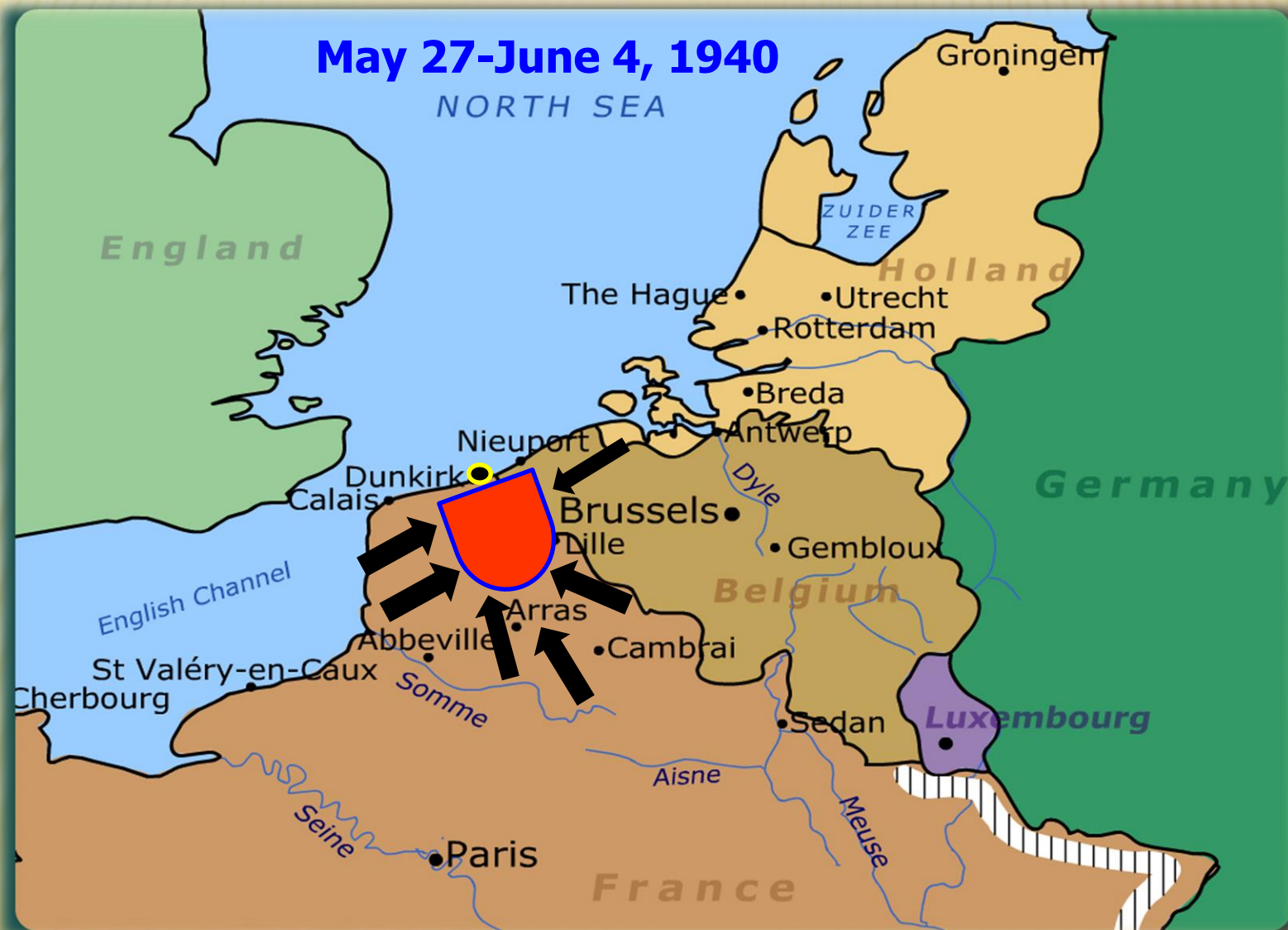
Intercession, Intercessory Prayer, Prayer for others – asking God for others' needs; *asking God on behalf of others, to act in their lives and situations in accordance with His will.*

Intercession is '**standing in the gap**' between God and a situation.

God has chosen to work in partnership with us, mainly through prayer. Intercession is agreeing with God to see his will done on earth. It's not about nagging God to get our will done in heaven.
